Cleaning and disinfecting

Frequently touched surfaces such as desks and door knobs will be disinfected as students leave classrooms. Bathrooms will be disinfected every hour. Students are required to bring their own school supplies (pencils, paper, rulers...). They will not be allowed to share. Teachers will have extra supplies in case there is a need.

Cohorting

Students will remain with their own classes throughout the day. This will include breaks and lunch.

Entrance, Egress, and Movement Within the School

At drop off and pick up, students will enter through the west parking lot gate. At drop off, once they have passed the health screening students will proceed to their class's designated area. Traffic patterns will be in place for one way movement on campus as much as possible. In addition, each classroom has 2 doors and windows for cross ventilation.

Face Coverings and Other Essential Protective Gear

Parents must provide each student with a mask. We recommend that it be on a lanyard/necklace, or be the type that can be pulled up when needed. Also, we ask that an extra mask be kept in their back pack. If your child has underlying health conditions we recommend that he/she wear a mask at all times while at school.

Health Screening for Students and Staff

Upon arrival, staff members will have their temperature taken, and fill out the Daily Symptom Screening and Temperature Check. Any staff member found to have symptoms will be sent home immediately. As students arrive, temperatures will be taken and questions asked at the cars. Any students with symptoms will be sent home immediately.

Healthy Hygiene Practices

Students will be required to wash their hand frequently throughout the day. Each student will be required to have their own hand sanitizer, tissues, and school supplies. There will be sanitizer available in each classroom and in strategic places on campus.

Identification and Tracing for Contacts

One staff member will be in charge of making all required contacts.

Physical Distancing

Upon arrival, students will have designated areas to set their back packs and meet their classes. Together they will proceed to class following traffic patterns. Desk barriers will be in place in each classroom, where procedures and traffic patterns will be in place.

For secondary, lockers will be assigned and each grade level will have their own bank of lockers. Classes will sit together at lunch.

Staff Training and Family Education

Per the state reopening plans, we are working as a staff to establish rules and procedures. We are creating instructional videos for our families to visually show them how we plan on implementing procedures.

Testing of Students and Staff

Any student or staff member who is found to have COVID symptoms will be sent home and require to go for testing. We will provide them with a list of current testing sites.

Triggers for Switching to Distance Learning

If 5% of our population comes down with COVID, we will switch to distance learning for the mandated time period.

Communication Plans

Will communicate with our parents by email, texts blasts, and paper copy.
