SCHOOL OVERVIEW

Apple Valley Christian Academy strives to be distinctively Christian, classically-flavored, and college preparatory by developing the Christian worldview through an academically rigorous liberal arts curriculum. AVCA is coeducational and is open to students from Preschool through 12th grade.

The Town of Apple Valley is located in the High Desert region of San Bernardino County, at about 3,000 feet elevation, surrounded by the beautiful mountains above San Bernardino. AVCA serves the communities of Apple Valley, Victorville, Hesperia, Adelanto, and Lucerne Valley.

Apple Valley Christian Academy was founded in 1976 as a ministry of the Apple Valley Baptist Church. These wonderful people of faith had a vision for a Christian school in this rural desert area and developed a long-range plan to support Christian education. The school began providing elementary education with 19 students in kindergarten and first grade. By 1988, AVCA had expanded to include a preschool through 12th grade program. In 2012, AVCA incorporated as *Apple Valley Christian Academy*, an independent Christian school with a very supportive school board.

CAMPUS DESCRIPTION

AVCA occupies an 11,000+ square foot traditional style campus owned by St. Timothy's Episcopal Church. It consists of 14 classrooms, including a Science Lab, Computer Lab, Library, Music Room and small Student Store. For large assemblies and Chapel, we have the use of the church sanctuary and meeting hall. Additionally,

there are multiple play spaces for everyone from Preschool to High School.

CLASSICAL EDUCATION

Classical Christian Education is a time-tested method used since the second century. Our curriculum complements the child's natural developmental phase with the appropriate teaching method. This inspires students to investigate, contemplate, debate, and pursue knowledge.

Apple Valley Christian Academy students are encouraged and prepared to become "thinking Christians" through an educational system that treats all subjects as part of an integrated whole, with Scripture at its center. We feel passionately that a classical Christian education best prepares students to confront every challenge with confidence and scholarship.

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

A successful academic record with demonstrated diligence, evidence of the potential to make a positive contribution to the school community, and a desire to live by Christian standards are important admission considerations. Teacher recommendations and a personal interview are required.

ENROLLMENT

The estimated total enrollment for 2022-2023 school year is 170: 25 Preschool students; 93 elementary students; 30 Middle School students; and 22 High School students. We also have approximately 10 students enrolled in Potter's Hand, our Private School Satellite Program.

FACULTY

There are 13 faculty members in K-12th grades, all of which are required to have Bachelor's Degrees, and one of which has a Master's Degree. All faculty are required to hold a current Educator's Certificate from the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). In Elementary School, the teacher to student

ratio is 1:15; in Middle School, 1:10; in High School, 1:8.

CURRICULUM

Classical Christian Education

Elementary curriculum is focused on materials from Memoria Press and Veritas Press, including English, Latin, Reading, Spelling, Math, History, and Geography. We have an excellent Bible curriculum that is produced by Summit Ministries. Enrichment subjects include Art, Choir, Computing, and Recorder Band.

Secondary curriculum includes English, Latin, Logic, Bible, History, Government/Economics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Pre-Algebra, Algebra, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, Philosophy, Spanish, Art, Band, Choir, and Drama.

The standard course load is seven classes per semester.

AVCA Online Academy: Our Online Academy allows for a wider variety of core and elective choices for on-campus students. We are partnering with Sevenstar Academy, who provides us with excellent academic content with a Christian worldview, along with close, careful monitoring. These are **UC certified and accredited courses** taught by qualified online teachers.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must have 270 credits to graduate. All students must take a minimum of four (4) classes per semester.

Bible: Four (4) years (or every semester in attendance at AVCA)

English: Four (4) years

Social Studies: Four (4) years

Mathematics: Three (3) years*

Science: Three (3) years*

Foreign Language: Two (2) years

Physical Education: Two (2) years – each team sport counts for ½ year.

Fine Arts: One (1) year in the categories of Art, Music, or Drama.

* An additional year of math or science is recommended

ADVANCED PLACEMENT/HONORS

The following AP courses are offered:

- Calculus AB
- Calculus BC

Students may also choose from the dual credit and AP course offerings of our AVCA Online Academy as well as the resources of our local community college, Victor Valley College, to obtain college credit for courses taken during high school.

Academy: English, Calculus, Statistics, World History.

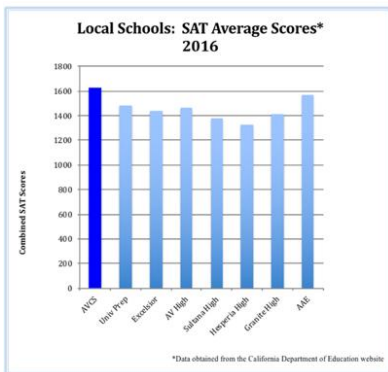

ATHLETICS

AVCA is a member of CIF and offers a variety of sports: Baseball, Softball, Boys' Basketball, Girls' Basketball, Boys' Volleyball, Girls' Volleyball, Cross-Country, Track and Field, and Cheerleading. It is noteworthy that AVCA requires students to maintain a 2.5 grade point average in order to be eligible to play on a sports team. This is higher than requirements at any other High Desert high school.

The High School Student Leadership Team is not just a class. It is a crash course in how to be a servant leader. It is a year-long, hands-on, leadership development program. It is a discipleship method for our staff to model *Christian Leadership Committed to Excellence*.
